

Completing your scorecard

For Qualifying Competitions and General Play scores, another player must fill in your scores and sign the card as your marker.

However, the competitor is solely responsible for checking the gross hole scores and other required details are correct and his/her signature an acknowledgement of what has been written.

The scorecard is considered to have been returned when it has been placed in the box provided.

Scorecard Checklist

- Competition title, General Play or 'For handicap', if working towards a WHS handicap.
- Date of play
- Name of player to whom the card belongs (Player A) and Handicap Index.
- Indicate the tee/colour played.
- Player A's gross hole scores written under column A.
(The marker may keep a record of their own scores under the marker's column or if shown as Player B, under Column B.
- Signatures of marker and competitor are at the bottom of the card.
- The card has been placed in the box.
